STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Trustees of Machiasport Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The citizens of the towns of Machiasport and
- 2 East Machias shall constitute a body politic and corporate
- 3 under the name of the Trustees of Machiasport Bridge, for
- 4 the purpose of building and maintaining a bridge between
- 5 said towns.
 - Sect. 2. Said trustees are hereby authorized and empow-
- 2 ered to erect and maintain a bridge over the west branch of
- 3 the Machias river, from a point near the dwelling house of
- 4 Melvin Morse, in Machiasport, to a point on the east side of
- 5 said river, near the Washington county railway station, in
- 6 East Machias; said bridge shall be built of suitable mate-

7 rials, shall not be less than eighteen feet in width, and shall 8 in all respects be made safe for the passage of travelers.

- Sect. 3. Said bridge shall be constructed with a good and 2 sufficient draw or hoist therein, over the deepest part of the 3 channel of the river, not less than 45 feet wide, with piers 4 or wharves, so that vessels may pass conveniently; and said 5 trustees shall cause said draw or hoist to be hoisted or opened 6 free of expense, and without unnecessary delay, for the 7 accommodation of all vessels, that may have occasion to pass 8 through the same; and said bridge shall be constructed so 9 that open boats (without masts), launches, and rafts of lum-10 ber can conveniently pass under the same; and said trustees 11 shall sink and maintain all necessary buoys and moorings 12 above and below said bridge, to facilitate the passage of ves-13 sels bound up and down said river through the draw of said 14 bridge.
 - Sect. 4. The inhabitants of the town of Machiasport and 2 the inhabitants of the town of East Machias, may raise and 3 appropriate money each year, and expend the same under 4 the direction of said trustees, in building, constructing and 5 maintaining said bridge.
 - Sect. 5. The affairs of said trustees shall be managed by 2 a board of fourteen members, seven of which shall be 3 selected by the inhabitants of each of said towns, and they 4 shall hold office for one year, except as herein provided.
 - Sect. 6. Said board of trustees may make and adopt from 2 time to time, such rules, by-laws and regulations for the

- 3 management of the affairs of the trustees; as they deem 4 necessary and proper.
- Sect. 7. The following named citizens of Machiasport;
- 2 Irving M. Bangs, Geo. A. Welch, B. F. Small, J. W. Cates,
- 3 F. H. Sanborn, S. N. Tobey, S. L. Bulson, and the following
- 4 named citizens of East Machias, C. Hollis White, Harry M.
- 5 Gardner, Carl G. Wiswell, James A. Foster, J. Anson Wis-
- 6 well, W. F. Pope and C. B. Ober, shall be and are hereby
- 7 constituted the first board of trustees authorized by this act,
- 8 and shall hold office until the last day of the next month of
- 9 March, after such bridge shall be completed and opened to 10 the public.
 - Sect. 8. Said trustees shall render their services without 2 compensation.
 - Sect. 9. The first meeting of the board of trustees named
 - 2 in this act may be called at the request of any one of said
 - 3 board, by giving each member personal notice of the time,
- 4 place and purpose of said meeting.
 - Sect. 10. This act shall take effect when approved.
