IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to an act providing an additional term of the supreme judicial court for the county of Oxford, approved by the governor March 9, A. D. 1907.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All actions or processes, civil or criminal com-2 menced on or before April 1st, 1907, returnable to the su-3 preme judicial court for the county of Oxford, made return-4 able to either the May term 1907, or the October term 1907, 5 shall be held to be returnable to and have day in the May 6 term A. D. 1907, and all attachments made by reason of said 7 actions or processes are hereby made legal and valid the 8 same as if said actions or processes were commenced after 9 April 1st, 1907, and made returnable to the term to be held 10 on the second Tuesday of May, A. D. 1907, and all actions
11 or processes now pending on the docket of the supreme judi12 cial court for the county of Oxford and continued at the
13 present March term of said court shall be continued to and
14 have day in the term to be held on the second Tuesday of
15 May, A. D. 1907.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
