STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the assessment of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Any person, association or corporation having 2 in its employ more than twenty-five men in any one town or 3 city in the State shall upon the written request of the chair-4 man of the board of assessors of that town or city furnish 5 to said board a complete list of the names of all men in its 6 employ in said town or city on the first day of the preced-7 ing April; said list shall be furnished within ten days from 8 the date of said request and neglect or refusal to compry 9 with the provisions of this act shall subject said person, 10 association or corporation to a penalty of fifty dollars to be

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11 recovered on an action or debt for the benefit of such towns,12 said action of debt shall be brought by the treasurer of said13 town or city in his name upon request of the assessors.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
