STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved: That the sum of five thousand dollars be and
2 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of purchasing a herd
3 of cattle for the Insane Hospital farm, providing, however,
4 that no cattle shall be placed on the farm before the first day
5 of October, A. D. 1907.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The entire herd of the Maine Insane Hospital has recently been condemned and are now being destroyed by order of the cattle commissioners, because of their infection with tuberculosis.
