## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter eighty-five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five relating to the appointment of receivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of chapter eighty-five of the

- 2 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking therefrom the words 'and all claims not
- 4 so presented shall be forever barred,' so that said section as
- 5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Whenever a receiver is appointed as above, the

- 7 court shall limit a time, not less than four months, of which
- 8 decree notice shall be given, within which all claims against
- 9 said corporations shall be presented, and make such order
- 10 for the manner of hearing and proving the same as may be
- II just and proper.'
