IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 32 of chapter 8 of the Revised Statutes, relating to excise tax on palace or other cars, for which extra compensation is charged for riding therein.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-two of chapter eight of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "four" in the sixth line and inserting the words 'four and one-
4 half' in place thereof, so that the whole section as amended
5 shall read:

'Sect. 32. Every corporation or person owning or opera-
7 ting palace or other cars for which extra compensation is

8 charged for riding therein over any of the railroads of the
9 state shall annually on the first day of September, pay to the
10 treasurer of state for the use of the state an annual excise
11 tax for the privilege of exercising its franchises in the state,
12 equal to four and one-half per cent of its or his gross receipts
13 from business done wholly in the state, for the year ending
14 June thirtieth next preceding.'
