STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit seining smelts in certain parts of Casco
Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any
2 time to catch smelts in the waters of Casco Bay adjacent
3 to the city of Portland above Portland Bridge and Grand
4 Trunk Railway Bridge in any way except by the ordinary
5 method of hook and line.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
2 be liable to a fine of fifty dollars for each offence upon
3 conviction.
