IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 10 of Chapter 433 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Portland Water District."

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars be and Section 1. Section ten of chapter four hundred thirty-

- 2 three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
- 3 seven, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Portland Water
- 4 District, is hereby amended by adding to said section the fol-
- 5 lowing, to wit:

'If during the term of office of any trustee a petition for a

- 7 new election signed by legal voters of the section of the dis-
- 8 trict in which the election is sought to the number equal to
- 9 twenty-five percentum of the total number of ballots cast and

10 counted for all the candidates for the position of trustee in II that portion of the district as aforesaid at the last previous 12 election be filed with the clerk of the town or municipality as 13 aforesaid the clerk of said town or municipality shall within 14 30 days after the filing of such petition duly call an election 15 in the manner provided for elections for trustees of the Water 16 District; the petition aforementioned being required to sim-17 ply give the name or names of the trustee or trustees which 18 it is sought to remove, which trustees whose removal is thus 19 sought shall be placed on the official ballot in alphabetical or-20 der with any other candidates which may be nominated, but 21 all other candidates for position of trustee shall have their 22 names placed upon the official ballot only after the usual peti-23 tion signed by 50 legal voters has been filed with the city 24 clerk as provided for in general elections for trustees for the 25 Water District.'
