#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

J. W. Haines, Town Clerk of Dexter, was a witness before the committee in the contested election case of Brown vs. Waldron of the 73d Legislature (1907). Through some error his fee for attendance was not paid to him at that time, and this resolve is for the purpose of paying his bill.
