STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for assistance in rebuilding the East
Branch bridge in the town of Oakfield.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in rebuilding
3 the bridge across the east branch of the Mattawamkeag
4 river near Oakfield station in the town of Oakfield, Aroos-
5 took county, provided that the amount herein appropriated
6 be expended under the direction of the State highway com-
7 missioner and the Aroostook county commissioners, and
8 provided further that the appropriation of seven hundred
9 and fifty dollars be conditional upon the expenditure of a
10 like sum by the town of Oakfield.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is to take the place of an appropriation of like amount made by the legislature of 1907 which is not available on account of unavoidable delays in the construction of the bridge, which have delayed the completion beyond the thirty-first day of December, 1908, on which date the appropriation made by the last legislature expired by limitation.
