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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter 55 of the Private and Special Laws  
of Maine for the year 1903, incorporating the Squirrel Island  
Village Corporation.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section five of Chapter fifty-five of the Private  
2 and Special Laws of Maine for the year nineteen hundred  
3 and three is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth  
4 line of said section the word "sixty" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the word "seventy-five," so that said section as  
6 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. The Town of Northport shall annually pay over  
8 to the treasurer of said corporation out of the taxes collected

9 from the inhabitants and estates on Squirrel Island a sum  
10 equal to seventy-five per centum of all the town taxes, ex-  
11 clusive of the State and County Tax, collected from said in-  
12 habitants and estates.'
