RESOLVE in favor of York Hospital.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the York Hospital the sum of one thousand five hundred
3 dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine, and one thou-
4 sand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred ten.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The York Hospital is located in town of York, and serves a large portion of the western part of the State. It is housed in two substantial buildings, well adapted to the purposes of a general hospital, and well equipped throughout. The appropriation herein recommended is the same amount as that of two years ago.
