STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Sanford
Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-
2 three of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
3 and five, amending chapter four hundred and sixty-nine of
4 the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one
5 which were extended by chapter eighty of the private and
6 special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby fur-
7 ther amended by striking out the whole of said section and

8 inserting the following, so that said section as amended
9 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Ernest M. Goodall, George B. Goodall, Louis
11 B. Goodall, M. A. Hewitt, George H. Nowell, Harmon G.
12 Allen, George G. Emery, Nat T. Abbott, George A. Good-
13 win, Newell T. Fogg, Hiram B. Rowe, S. Benton Emery
14 and Fred J. Allen of Sanford, Justin M. Leavitt, of Kenne-
15 bunkport, Samuel M. Came of Alfred, E. J. Eddy, Charles
16 S. Cook and George S. Hobbs of Portland, their associates,
17 successors and assigns, are hereby made a body corporate
18 and politic to be known as the Sanford Trust Company,
19 and as much shall be possessed of all the powers, privileges
20 and immunities and subject to all the duties and obligations
21 conferred on such corporations by law.'

Sect. 2. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sanford
2 Trust Company, which were amended by chapter four hun-
3 dred and sixty-nine of the private and special laws of nine-
4 teen hundred one, as amended by section one of this act, are
5 hereby extended for one year from the approval of this act,
6 and the persons named in said act and their associates and
7 successors shall have all the rights, powers and privileges
8 that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the
9 same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said
10 act; provided, however, that said company shall actually
11 commence business as a trust company within said one year.
