IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Brewer Savings Bank, of Brewer,
Penobscot County, Maine, to construct and maintain Safety
Deposit Boxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Brewer Savings Bank, of Brewer, Penob-
scot County, Maine, is hereby authorized and empowered to
construct, own, maintain, operate and rent for hire safety
deposit boxes for the safe keeping of personal property; pro-
vided, however, that said savings bank shall not be liable for
any loss of property deposited in said boxes for safe keeping,
beyond the sum paid for the hire of the box containing said
property so lost; and provided further that the construction

9 of said deposit boxes, and their location within the vaults
 10 owned or occupied and controlled by said bank shall be sub-
 11 ject to the approval of the state bank examiner, who shall
 12 make careful examination, and certify his approval to said
 13 bank.
