IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Fairfield and Skowhegan
Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers, and privileges of the Fairfield and Skowhegan Railway Company, which were granted by chapter two hundred sixty, of the private and special laws of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act, and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers, and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
