IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide for ice fishing in Round pond, in the town
of Greenwood, Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 1 of chapter 407 of the
2 private and special laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing through
3 the ice, as provided in the general laws of the State, in
4 Round pond, in the town of Greenwood, Oxford County,
5 from February first of each year until the ice is out of said
6 pond the following spring, is hereby repealed.
