AN ACT authorizing the Union Construction Company to hold
stock and bonds of other Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Union Construction Company, a corpo-
2 ration duly organized under the laws of the State of Maine,
3 which organization is hereby ratified, confirmed and declared
4 to be legal and valid, is hereby authorized and empowered
5 to acquire, hold and dispose of shares of capital stock and
6 mortgage bonds of other corporations.
