IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to transfer the duties prescribed by chapter twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes relating to protection of life in buildings used for public purposes, from the Board of Fire Engineers of the City of Portland, to the Building Inspector of said City.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The duties to be discharged by the board of
2 fire engineers of the city of Portland in accordance with
3 sections thirty-nine, forty and forty-two of chapter twenty-
4 eight of the Revised Statutes relating to the protection of
5 life in buildings used for public purposes, shall hereafter
6 be discharged by the building inspector of said city of Port-

7 land, and the forfeit provided in section forty-four of said
8 chapter twenty-eight shall be enforced against said building
9 inspector for refusal or neglect to perform the duties in
10 accordance with the provisions of said chapter twenty-eight.
