IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Franklin Power Company to transmit, sell and distribute electricity in the towns of Farmington and New Vineyard.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Franklin Power Company, a corporation
2 organized under the laws of the State of Maine, its suc-
3 cessors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered
4 to sell, supply, transmit and distribute electricity for light-
5 ing, heating, manufacturing and mechanical purposes in
6 the towns of Farmington and New Vineyard in the county
7 of Franklin.

Sect. 2. Said company is hereby authorized to construct
2 and maintain transmission lines for electricity, under,
3 through, along, over and across the highways, ways, streets,
4 railroads and bridges in said towns.

In all things said company shall be subject to the public
6 laws of the State applicable to similar corporations.
