AN ACT to authorize the town of Harpswell to construct and maintain a bridge from Great Island in said Harpswell to Hen Island on which Fred E. Darling now lives.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Harpswell is hereby authorized  
2 to lay out, construct and maintain a bridge from Great Is-  
3 land in said Harpswell to Hen Island on which said Fred  
4 E. Darling now lives.

Sect. 2. The said town, and officers thereof, shall have  
2 all the powers relating to said bridge, which are now pro-  
3 vided by law in case of town ways.
