RESOLVE, in favor of Maine Children's Home Society.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for the use of the Maine
3 Children's Home Society of Augusta, for the year nineteen
4 hundred and nine and twelve hundred and fifty dollars for
5 the year nineteen hundred and ten. Should there be any un-
6 expended balance of said appropriation for a particular year,
7 such balance shall not lapse, but may be expended in the year
8 next succeeding.
