IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Danforth Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Dan2 forth Trust Company which were granted by Chapter three
3 hundred and seventy-seven of the Private and Special Laws
4 of nineteen hundred and seven are hereby extended for one
5 year from the approval of this act, and the persons named in
6 said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the
7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by
8 said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the
9 same purposes as therein specified; provided, however, that
10 said company shall actually commence business as a trust
11 company within said one year.
