IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Sandy River Trust
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sandy
2 River Trust Company, which were granted by chapter one
3 hundred and forty of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
4 teen hundred and seven, are hereby extended for one year
5 from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said
6 act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
7 powers and privileges that were granted them by the said
8 act to be exercised in the same manner and for the same
9 purposes as specified in said act; provided, however, that
10 said company shall actually commence business as a trust
11 company within said one year.
