AN ACT to extend the charter of the Lincoln County Street
Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All the rights, powers and privileges of the Lincoln County
2 Street Railway which were granted by Chapter twenty-
3 three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
4 and three are hereby extended to April first, one thousand
5 nine hundred and eleven.
