STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a weir in tide waters
of the Saint Croix river in the town of Robbinston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Howard F. Fisher of Robbinston in the county
2 of Washington, is hereby authorized to build and maintain
3 a weir for fishing purposes in tide waters in front of land
4 of Esther Vose of said Robbinston; providing that the owner
5 of said land shall assent thereto and that said weir does not
6 interfere with navigation or the rights of shore owners.

Sect. 2. The above mentioned weir shall be located at
2 least 1000 feet from the body of any weir now located in
3 said waters.
