STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Webster Plantation, in the County of Penobscot.

Resolved: That there be paid by the treasurer of State, 2 to Webster Plantation, in the County of Penobscot, the sum 3 of one hundred and nine dollars and fifty-nine cents, it being 4 the amount due to said Webster Plantation as its proportion 5 of the school fund and mill tax for the year 1905, and re-6 maining unpaid.



STATEMENT OF FACTS

Accompanying Resolve in Favor of Webster Plantation. In the year 1905 the sum of one hundred and nine dollars and fifty-nine cents was apportioned to Webster Plantation as its proportion of the school fund and mill tax for said year, but said sum has never been paid to said Webster Plantation.
