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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of John M. Taylor.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred ninety-two dollars  
2 be and hereby is appropriated to be paid John M. Taylor  
3 of Cape Elizabeth for expense of clerk hire incurred by  
4 him in performance of his duties as State inspector of  
5 steam vessels during the years nineteen hundred seven and  
6 nineteen hundred eight.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the performance of his duties the inspector of steam vessels is necessarily absent from his headquarters many days in succession, and the employment of a clerk is absolutely necessary. No appropriation was made for the purpose in 1907, and therefore there were no funds to pay the bill.
