## STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Saddleback stream, sometimes called Pease stream, in Franklin County.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of section 2 of chapter 407 of the  
2 private and special laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing in  
3 Saddleback stream, sometimes called Pease stream, in the  
4 county of Franklin, from the junction of the Sandy river  
5 and said Saddleback, or Pease stream, so called, at Madrid  
6 Village, to Orrin Hinckley's bridge, so called, a distance  
7 of one mile, is hereby repealed.
