IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT amending Chapter 146 of the Special Laws of 1895
relating to Commissioner of Public Works for the City of
Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 146 of the Special Laws
2 of 1895 is hereby amended by striking out the words "who
3 shall be a civil engineer and" in the sixth line thereof, so
4 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The mayor of the city of Portland is hereby
6 authorized and empowered to appoint on the second Mon-
7 day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
8 hundred and ninety-five, or as soon thereafter as may be,
9 subject to the approval of the board of aldermen, a com-

10 missioner of public works who shall hold office for three
11 years at the first appointment under this act, and until his
12 successor is qualified; each succeeding appointment there-
13 after shall be for the term of three years. He shall receive
14 such salary as the city council may determine. In case any
15 vacancy should occur, it may be filled in the same manner
16 for the unexpired term. He may be removed by the mayor
17 for cause, subject to the approval of the board of aldermen.'
