AN ACT to open Mayfield and Kingsbury ponds, in Somerset
County, to ice fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice, in ac-
2 cordance with the general law of the State, in Mayfield and
3 Kingsbury ponds, in Somerset County.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
