STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section five and repeal section nine of chapter ninety-two of the public laws of nineteen hundred five, providing for the better enforcement of the laws against the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section I. Section five of chapter ninety-two of the public 2 laws of nineteen hundred five is hereby amended so that said 3 section as amended shall read as follows:
- "Sect. 5. It shall be the duty of the said deputy enforce-
- 5 ment commissioners to exercise all the powers herein con-
- 6 ferred when, where and as directed by said commission, and
- 7 for their services they shall be paid by the county where such
- 8 powers are exercised, three dollars per day and the actual

9 expenses occasioned by the performance of such duty. Said 10 fees and expenses shall be audited and allowed as provided 11 by revised statutes, chapter one hundred thirty-seven, sec12 tion one."

Sect. 2. Section nine of chapter ninety-two of the pub-2 lic laws of nineteen hundred five is hereby repealed.
