IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit the use of automobiles in the towns of Eden, Mount Desert, Tremont and Southwest Harbor, on the Island of Mount Desert.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No automobile or motor vehicle shall be set up,

- 2 used, driven or operated in or on any highway, townway,
- 3 or public street within any of the towns of Eden, Mount
- 4 Desert, Tremont and Southwest Harbor, on the Island of
- 5 Mount Desert, in the County of Hancock, State of Maine.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever sets up, uses, drives or operates any
- 2 automobile or motor vehicle contrary to the provisions of
- 3 Section 1 hereof shall on first conviction be punished by a
- 4 fine of twenty dollars and costs of prosecution, and on sec-

8 prisonment.

- 5 ond and every subsequent conviction shall be punished by a 6 fine of fifty dollars and costs of prosecution or by imprison-7 ment for not exceeding sixty days or by both fine and im-
- Sect. 3. The words motor vehicle, as herein used, shall 2 not be construed to include steam road rollers used by au3 thority of the Town Officers.
- Sect. 4. In such of the said towns as shall accept this act 2 at any legal meeting called by a warrant containing an ar-3 ticle for that purpose, this act shall, subject to the provis-4 ions of the State Constitution thereto applicable, take effect 5 ten days after it shall be so accepted.
