STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the City of Portland to acquire land for
a police station and a central fire station.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of the City of Portland
2 are hereby authorized, upon vote of the city council of said
3 city, to take and condemn, in the name and on behalf of said
4 city, such lands, with any buildings or dwellings thereon, as
5 may be by said municipal officers found necessary or suit-
6 able for the use and erection of a police station and a central
7 fire station in said city.

Sect. 2. Notice of the taking of such land shall be given
2 and such damages assessed as are prescribed by sections

3 ninety and ninety-one of Chapter four of the Revised Stat-
4 utes.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
