IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT amendatory to Section one of the Charter of the City of Bangor, relating to corporate name and powers.

·Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of the charter of the city of Ban-2 gor is hereby amended by adding after the word "politic" 3 in the twelfth line of said section the following:

"and the health and safety of the inhabitants of said city
5 and to so regulate the construction and maintenance of the
6 roofs of buildings in said city as to prevent snow and ice
7 from sliding therefrom into the streets," so that said section
8 when so amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. That the inhabitants of the town of Bangor shall 10 continue to be a body politic and corporate by the name of

II the city of Bangor, and, as such, shall have, exercise and en-12 joy all the rights, immunities, powers, privileges and fran-13 chises, and shall be subject to all the duties and obligations 14 now appertaining to or incumbent on said town, as a munici-15 pal corporation, or appertaining to or incumbent upon the 16 inhabitants or officers thereof; and may ordain and establish 17 such acts, laws and regulations, not inconsistent with the 18 constitution and laws of this State as shall be needful to the 10 good order of said body politic, and the health and safety of 20 the inhabitants of said city, and to so regulate the construc-21 tion and maintenance of the roofs of buildings in said city 22 as to prevent snow and ice from sliding therefrom into the 23 streets; and impose fines and penalties for the breach there-24 of, not exceeding fifty dollars for any offense, to be recov-25 ered by action of debt, in the name of the city treasurer or 26 upon complaint of the police officer as for a criminal of-27 fense.
