RESOLVE, in favor of Aroostook Central Institute.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated for
2 the use of the trustees of Aroostook Central Institute the
3 sum of three hundred dollars for 1909 and three hundred
4 dollars for 1910.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Aroostook Central Institute is practically without endowment and is helping to meet the educational needs of a large community outside of the town in which it is located. Its income from all sources is insufficient to meet the necessary expenses of maintenance and aid is asked from the State to partially make up the deficiency.
