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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Section eighty of Chapter fifteen of the Re-  
vised Statutes of Maine, relating to State aid for academies.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eighty of chapter fifteen of the Re-  
vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word  
"thirty" in the third line and inserting in place thereof the  
word "twenty-five;" also by striking out the word "sixty"  
in the fifth line of said section and inserting in place thereof  
the word "fifty," so that said section as amended shall read  
as follows:

'Section 80. No academy shall receive State aid under  
section seventy-six unless the average attendance in said

10 academy for the year preceding, or for five years next pre-  
11 ceding, shall exceed twenty-five students, and no academy  
12 shall receive to exceed five hundred dollars unless the aver-  
13 age attendance in said academy for the year preceding shall  
14 exceed fifty students.”
