IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Phillips Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Phillips Trust Company, located at Phillips, Franklin County, Maine, which were granted by chapter three hundred and twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, approved March 26, 1903, are hereby extended for one year, from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said original act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified therein; provided, however, that said company shall actually commence business as a trust company within said one year.
