IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 164 of the Private and
Special Laws of 1907, relating to fishing in the tributaries to
China Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 164 of the Private and Spe-
2 cial Laws of 1907 is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "so called" in the second line the words "or its tribu-
4 taries," so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol-
5 lows:

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
7 kill any kind of fish through the ice in China lake, so-called,
8 or its tributaries, in China and Vassalboro, in the County of
9 Kennebec, or in Lovejoy pond, so-called, in Albion, in said
10 County of Kennebec.'
