STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Donnell pond, so-called, situated partly in Franklin and partly in Township No. 10, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time through the ice in Donnell
3 pond, so called, situated partly in Franklin and partly in
4 Township No. 10, Hancock County, except on Tuesday and
5 Friday of each week, in accordance with the general law of
6 the State.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the

3 general law of the State for illegal fishing for and catching
4 trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices, in their respective counties,
3 shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with the su-
4 preme and superior courts.
