IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT creating an open time on gray and black squirrels in
York, Kennebec and Washington Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful from the fourteenth day of
2 September to the first day of the following November of
3 each year to hunt and kill gray and black squirrels in the
4 counties of York, Kennebec and Washington. So much of
5 chapter 85 of the Public Laws of 1907 as is inconsistent with
6 this act is hereby repealed.
