STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, for the erection of a fish hatchery and feeding station on Cold Stream, the outlet of Cold Stream lake, in Enfield.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand five hundred
2 dollars for the year 1909 and one thousand five hundred dol-
3 lars for the year 1910 be and is hereby appropriated for the
4 purpose of acquiring suitable land and erecting a suitable
5 fish hatchery and feeding station for the artificial propaga-
6 tion of fish to re-stock the waters of Penobscot, Washing-
7 ton and Hancock Counties, to be located on Cold Stream,
8 the outlet of Cold Stream lake, in Enfield, Penobscot Coun-
9 ty, to be expended by the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries
10 and Game, under the direction of the Governor and Coun-
11 cil.
