STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to increase the salary of the Judge of the Superior
Court for Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 5 of Section 1 of Chapter 116 of
2 the Revised Statutes of Maine, is hereby amended by striking
3 out of said paragraph the words "two thousand five hun-
4 dred" and inserting in place thereof the words "three thou-
5 sand," so that said paragraph when amended shall read as
6 follows:

“Justice of the superior court for the county of Kennebec,
8 three thousand dollars; there shall be allowed to him in addi-
9 tion to said salary, for the purpose of meeting his extra ex-
10 penses entailed by holding said court at the city of Water-
11 ville, the sum of one hundred dollars for each and every
12 term of said court so held at the city of Waterville.”
