House Amendment A to House Document No. 184.

Amend by adding the following sections:

Sect. 3. The antitoxine shall be kept by the secretary
2 or chairman of the local board, and shall be furnished
3 physicians upon application on blanks provided and fur-
4 nished by the State Board.

Sect. 4. The local board shall provide a repository for
2 antitoxine which may be furnished to any physician at the
3 same rates as furnished by the State Board of Health and
4 to their patients on prescription. The local board of health
5 in any town furnishing an indigent residing in another town
6 antitoxine upon application, as above provided, shall be
7 reimbursed by the town where the patient resides. The
8 State shall reimburse cities or towns furnishing antitoxine
9 to any person having no legal residence in any city or town
10 within the State.
