STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Dead Cambridge river, in Upton and "C" Surplus, and tributaries, also tributaries to C. pond, in Township "C" surplus, Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Dead Cambridge river,
3 so-called, in Upton and Township "C" Surplus, from Um-
4 bagog lake to C. pond, or in any of the tributaries to said
5 river except Swift Cambridge river, so called, or in any of
6 the tributaries to "C" pond, so-called, which pond is sit-
7 uated in Township "C." Surplus, except in the ordinary
8 method of casting with artificial flies or fly fishing.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
3 the general law of the State for illegal fishing for and catch-
4 ing trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this chapter, municipal
2 and police courts and trial justices, within their respective
3 counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concur-
4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts.
