STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and eighty-nine of the Laws of nineteen hundred and seven prohibiting publications relating to patent or other medicines in language of immoral tendency, or of ambiguous character, and protecting the public against the dangers from the indiscriminate distribution of samples of medicine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and eighty2 nine of the laws of nineteen hundred and seven is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "sale" in the first
4 line thereof the words "or distribution by hand or other5 wise," so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol6 lows:

'Section I. The publication or sale or distribution by hand 8 or otherwise within this State of any circular, pamphlet, or 9 book containing recipes or prescriptions for the cure of 10 chronic female complaints or private diseases, or recipes or 11 prescriptions for drops, pills, tinctures, or other compounds 12 designed to prevent conception, or tending to produce mis-13 carriage or abortion is hereby prohibited; and for each copy 14 thereof, so published and sold, containing such prohibited 15 recipes or prescriptions, the publisher and seller shall each 16 be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be liable to 17 the same penalties provided for a violation of the preceding 18 section. Any person or persons, their agents or clerks, who 19 shall fail to comply with the requirements herein expressed, 20 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable 21 to a fine not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dol-22 lars, or to imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding three 23 months, or both, for each and every offense.'

Sect. 2. Section two of said chapter is hereby amended 2 by striking out in line seven of said section the words "that 3 contains poison or other ingredient deleterious to health," 4 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who, by him-6 self, his servant or agent, or as the servant or agent of any 7 other person or firm, shall leave, throw, or deposit, or have 8 in his possession with intent to leave, throw or deposit upon 9 the doorstep, hall, porch, doorway, vestibule, or premises 10 owned or occupied by another, any patent or proprietary 11 medicine or any preparation, pill, tablet, or drug, shall be
12 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a
13 fine of not less than twenty nor more than one thousand dol14 lars or by imprisonment for not less than thirty days nor
15 more than one year.'
