STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in the town of Durham.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish in any pond, brook or river in the town
3 of Durham, in the county of Androscoggin, for a period of
4 five years from the time this act takes effect, except during
5 the months of June, July and August of each year it shall
6 be lawful to fish in these waters, in accordance with the
7 general law of the State, on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thurs-
8 day of each week.

Sect. 2. During the open season on these waters it shall
2 be unlawful for any one person to take, catch, kill or have

3 in possession in any one day more than forty fish in all taken
4 from these waters.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and catch-
4 ing trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, munici-
2 pal and police courts and trial justices, within their respec-
3 tive counties, shall have, by complaint, original and concur-
4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts.
