STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the president and secretary of the trustees
of the Maine Insane and Eastern Maine Insane Hospitals to
execute a deed for certain lands in Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Section 1. The president and secretary of the trustees of
2 the Maine Insane and Eastern Maine Insane Hospitals are
3 hereby authorized and empowered to execute in behalf of
4 the State of Maine, a deed conveying to the city of Bangor
5 a certain lot or parcel of land situate on the northerly side
6 of State Street in said city of Bangor, bounded and de-
7 scribed as follows, viz:

Beginning on the northerly line of State Street at an iron
9 bolt on the westerly line of land now owned by the Eastern

10 Maine Insane Hospital of the State of Maine; thence north
11 eight (8) degrees thirty (30) minutes east on said hospital
12 line five hundred twenty-seven and one-half ($527\frac{1}{2}$) feet
13 to a stake on the southerly line of Garland Street; thence
14 easterly on the continuation of said Garland Street two hun-
15 dred twenty-four and seven-tenths ($224\frac{7}{10}$) feet to a
16 stake; thence southerly parallel with the dividing line be-
17 tween the original Treat and Drummond Farms five hun-
18 dred twenty-seven and forty-five hundredths ($527\frac{45}{100}$)
19 feet to a point on said northerly line of State Street, two
20 hundred twenty-seven (227) feet easterly of the place of be-
21 ginning; thence westerly on said line of State Street two hun-
22 dred twenty-seven (227) feet to the point begun at.

Sect. 2. Said city of Bangor to pay to the treasurer of
2 State the sum of three thousand dollars in full settlement for
3 same.
