AN ACT to extend the charter of the Dexter Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Dexter Trust Company, which were granted by Chapter three hundred and thirty-four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for one year; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act as amended, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said act; provided, however, that said company shall actually commence business as a trust company within said one year.
