STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of roads in Indian Township.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the construction and repair of roads and bridges in the Indian Township, Washington County, for the year 1909 and three thousand five hundred dollars for the year 1910. Each of the above appropriations shall be expended in each year as follows:

One thousand dollars for ordinary maintenance and repairs of the roads in said township and two thousand five hundred dollars for the permanent improvement of said roads; said appropriation to be expended under the direction of the State commissioner of highways.
