IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter 538 of the Private and Special Laws of 1889 relating to the taking of Smelts in the Sheepscot River, as amended by Chapter 165 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter 538 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1889 as amended by chapter 165 of the Pri-
3 vate and Special Laws of 1907 is hereby amended by strik-
4 ing out from said section the words "A line from Thorpe
5 island in Boothbay in a southwesterly direction to Low point
6 in Georgetown on a line drawn across all tide waters from
7 shore to shore from Thorpe island to Low point and all
8 coves on said line between said points" and inserting in place

9 thereof the words 'Wiscasset Bridge' so that said section
10 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. No person shall fish for smelts in the Sheep-
12 scot river or its tributaries between Wiscasset Bridge and
13 head of tide in Alma except by hook and line.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
